French Class Facilitator Position (Part-Time: 2 hours on Wednesday evening):

The French Class Teacher reports to the Executive Assistant and is in charge of delivering the French Conversation curriculum for beginner level virtually on Wednesday evenings. The program is aimed at helping adults to improve their level of speaking French and is not intended to replace or substitute a FSL Program.

Job Responsibilities:

Under the direct supervision of the Executive Assistant:

- Prepare lesson plans in accordance with the curriculum in place.
- Keep track of teaching topics.
- Submit a weekly student attendance sheet.
- Follow up on student progress.
- Familiarize him/herself with objectives, policies and procedures of the organization and responds to or directs student enquiries.
- Advise Executive Assistant of any classroom management issues, especially regarding attendance.

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree (B.Ed. preferred).
- Experience teaching adult French classes.
- Sensitivity to immigrant and multicultural issues.
- Familiarity with the community services (local, provincial and federal).
